PCA Activities

Currently activities include:

- Providing information and producing publications about Seychelles native plants.
- Providing advice and information on vegetation rehabilitation techniques and protocols.
- Providing advice on the propagation of native species.
- Exploratory and social field excursions for members and other interested people, to increase knowledge of native plants and plant conservation.
- Increasing awareness about, and advocacy for, plant conservation through co-organising and participating in appropriate workshops, conferences, training programmes, meetings, etc.
- Increasing awareness about Seychelles plants through participation in national and local events, e.g. Environment Day, Biodiversity Day, Earth Day, NGO community events.
- Sharing plant conservation research, information and news of PCA activities, etc. through production of the bi-annual newsletter "Kapisen".
- Initiating and coordinating projects relating to plants and plant conservation, habitat restoration, etc., often in partnership with other NGOs and/or the private sector.
